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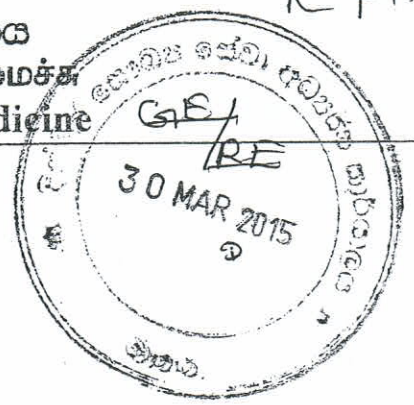


**Register for Patients Exposed to Mammal Bite and Vaccine Return on Anti Rabies Post Exposure Therapy**

The annual cost of Post exposure therapy (PET) is 350 million. In the work shop held epidemiology unit it was suggested to introduce a new OPD register for mammal bite and revise the monthly vaccine return of PET for speedy monitoring of consumption of human rabies vaccine and serum. This mammal bite register is important for planning and implementing rabies preventive strategies such as anti rabies dog vaccinations and dog sterilization activities and also for and it is very important to send this duly filled monthly return to assess the annual vaccine usage and to estimate the vaccine requirement for the subsequent year. Therefore, it is the

subsequent year. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the head of the institution to see that following guidelines are strictly followed by the staff.

1) A register of patients exposed to mammal bites should be prepared in each hospital where PET facilities are available (Annex I- the format of the register). Even the information of the patients to whom PET is not initiated according to the protocol should be included in the mammal bite register. At the end of the each day a daily summary should be prepared from the above mentioned register (Annex II- the format of the daily summary).

2) The anti rabies vaccine return (annexed III) should be prepared monthly and should be sent before 5<sup>th</sup> of the following month as mentioned in the vaccine return.
